Abstract: In Sweden, the first known telemedicine trial took place around 1915, in the field of remote reading of ECG signals across the campus at Lund University. Sea-to-shore telemedicine started in the beginning of the 1920s from Sahlgren University Hospital, in Gothenburg, to Swedish vessels around the world, a service that is still operational today. This makes Sweden one of the pioneering countries in telemedicine.
